



SD-15 أفضل برج حفر لعام 2017-2018

تتميز شركة نفط الكويت في القطاع النفطي كونها الشركة الوحيدة التي تقدم خدمات الاستكشاف والإنتاج محلياً، ولهذا فإنها تمتلك الخبرة اللازمة في أعمال حفر المكامن النفطية، وهي تسعى دائماً للتطور وتحسين أعمالها لتتبوأ المراكز القيادية محلياً وإقليمياً وعالمياً. ويعتبر العنصر البشري العامل الأساسي في هذا التألق والنجاح، ويتضح ذلك جلياً في المبادرة التي أقدم عليها فريق عمل الحفر التطويري وإصلاح الآبار (5) ضمن مجموعة الحفر التطويري (2) منذ ثلاث سنوات تحت عنوان "أقضل برج حقر للعام". رئيس الغريق دخيل العنزي هو الذي أطلق المبادرة، لذا توجهنا اليه وأجرينا معه لقاءً للتعرف أكثر على هذه المبادرة التنافسية التي تجرى كل عام داخل الفريق المسؤول عن 13 برج حفر، وللتعرف أيضاً على خطوات عمليات الحفر والمقاييس التي تؤخذ في الاعتبار لتحديد البرج الفَّائز بلقب أفضل برج حفر، والذي فاز بأحدث نسختها للسنة المالية (2017 - 2018) برج حفر SD-15 في منطقة شمال الكويت.



عدد أيام الحقر التي تتراوح من 25 يوماً إلى

ومن المقاييس التي توضع في الاعتبار لاختيار أفضل برج حقر للعام، هي الإبقاء على العمالة الأساسية لدى المقاول وعدم تغييرها أو نقلها إلى مواقع عمل أخرى، وما ينتج عن ذلك من تركيز في العمل ورفع معدل الإنتاجية.

دور الشركة وتعاون مشترك

وتلعب الشركة الـدور الأساسي في هذا الإنجاز، وذلك من خُلال تقديم التوصيات والتوجيهات اللازمة للمقاول الذي بدوره يقوم بمهمة التنفيذ، إذ تتعاون الفرق المعنية بالشركة على بعض المهام الأولية والأساسية للوصول إلى نتائج مثمرة، بدءاً من تصميم البئر وتحديد عمق أنابيب التغليف، إلى إعداد برنامج الحفر المعني به فريق عمل ممليات الحقر، حيث يحتوي هذا البرتامج على تفاصيل دقيقة تتعلق بتصعيم البئر، وتصميم التغليف، واختيار رأس الحفر، وأوزان ونوع ومكونات سوائل الحفر أو ما يعرف

بالـ"طفلة". ويعمل قريق عمل الحفر التطويري وإصلاح الأبار (5) على تحديد أعماق ومراحل الحقر لضمان سلاسة عملية الحفر وتجنب علقان الأنبوب، وهي مشكلة غائعة أثناء الحقر يعود سببها إلى وجود الشوائب والصخور الناتجة عن عملية الحفر أو السرعة الزائدة لدوران الحقر، أو يسبب عدم استخدام الوزن الأمثل للطفلة، أو قد يعلق الأتبوب لأسباب ميكانيكية بسبب شكل بعض الآبار التي قد تكون ماثلة في بعض الأصان، فهذه العوامل كافة بجب مراعاتها لتجنب التعقيدات في عملية الحفر ولتحقيق لقب أفضل برج حفر،

يشرف النفريق على 13 بــرم حــفـر حالـيـاً فــي مختلف مناطق الكويت، ويحتام كلّ برج حفر إلى 70 موظفاً لتشغيله في النوبتين

وهذا النجاح لا يكتمل إلا بتعاون المقاول المعنى وهو شركة Sun Drilling في هذه الحالة، إذ يتمثل دوره في مهارته وسرعته في عملية إنزال عمود الحفر ورفعه (Tripping) من الحفرة ومن ثم عملية التغليف أو التبطين، كما أنه المسؤول عن تغيير أحجام موانع الانفجار، وسرعة نقل برج الحفر من بثر إلى أُخرى، ويتأخر بعض المقاولين في نقل برج الحفر لأسباب غدة كعدم وجود وسيلة نقل لديهم، أو لنقص في الخبرة الكافية لإتمام نقل برج الحفر في أسرع وقت ممكن، أو لأن مهارات العمالة ليست بالشكل المطلوب، كما أن برنامج الصيانة لدى المقاول يؤثر بشكل كبير على أداثه، وهذا بالتأكيد يستدعي توفير العمالة اللازمة والماهرة لأداء هذه العملية يأقل تكلفة وجهد وزمن.

محتوى برنامج الحقر

وعند الشروع بحفر الآبار، يتم الاستعداد لتنفيذ برامج الحفر "PDDP" المعتمدة بالتعاون مع إدارة الحفر التطويري وإدارات

من المعهد الأميركي للبترول، ثم يقوم فريق عمل الحفر التطويري بإضافة بضع صفحات لاستكمال هذا البرنامج، وعند اكتماله يقوم العنزى باعتماده. وتتمثل خطوات إعداد برنامج الحفر أولاً في إعداد الخطة المبدئية التي يقوم الجيولوجيون

العاملون بإدارات تطوير الحقول بإعدادها، عن طريق تحديد أعماق الحفر وتزويد فريق عمل الحفر التطويري وإصلاح الآبار (5) بسانات عن ضغوط طبقات الأرض المحتملة، ومن ثم تذهب الخطة إلى إدارات التطوير الهندسي التي تحدد عمق التغليف، وبهذا يتكون برنامج بيانات ما قبل الحفر "PDDP". وعند استلام الفريق البرتامج، يضيف المزيد من البيانات عليه، كبرنامج لتحديد مثقاب الحفر لكل مقطع يتم حفره، وتتم كذلك إضافة الخطة التوجيهية التي تشمل شكل البئر وطرق حفرها بزوابا معينة لتجنب المشاكل أو الاحتكاك الزائد، إضافة إلى برنامج مخصص لأوزان سوائل الحفر، فضلاً عن برنامج إجراء الحفر الذي يشمل تفاصيل عملية الحفر بخطواتها المختلفة

تحديات عملية الحفر

ومن أكبر التحديات التي تواجه عملية الحفر، حقيقة أن عامل الحفر أو المهندس لن يتسنى له يوماً رؤية حفرة الإنتاج التي قد تكون على عمق خمسة كيلومترات، وهذا يعنى أن المخيلة والإبداع يلعبان دوراً كبيراً في التعامل مع الث لتقديم الحلول وفهم ما يحدث وابتكار سيناريوهات مناسبة وفعالة في حال وقوع طارئ أو حادث يتسبب في ليل عملية الحقر.

وقد يكون المعطل أنبوب عالق بسبب عطل ميكانيكي أو يسبب خلل في وزن سائل الحقر، وفي هذه الحالة يسعى العاملون لإخراجه من خلال طرق مختلفة، وفي حال عدم خروج الأنبوب يتم قصه عن طريق تفجيره، وبهذا ينشطر الأتبوب ولكن يتبقى جزء منه داخل الحقرة، فيثم تطبيق إجراء الصيد "FISHING" لإضراج ما تبقى من

أكد العنزى أن مهنة الحفر تعتبر ثاني أخطر المهن في العالم، إذ يقف عامل الحقر في الخطوط الأمامية معزضاً حياته للخطر بالإصابة أو حتى الموت في بعض الأحيان، ما يجعل هذه المهنة غابة في الدقة والتعقيد وتتطلب الكثير من المهارة والمهنية والتأهب الداثم والالتزام بمعايير الصحة والسلامة والبيئة لتجنب أي حادث أو إصابة.

وانطلاقاً من هذا الواقع، أطلق العنزي مبادرة أفضل برج حفر للعام" منذ ثلاث سنوات لتحفيز وتشجيع العاملين والمقاولين على بذل قصارى جهدهم وأفضل ما لديهم لتحقيق أكبر عدد من ساعات العمل الأمنة وإنمام عمليات الحف بأقا تكلفة ووقت وجعد ممكن، لا سيما أن عدد الموظفين في الفريق يقارب ألف موظف ما بين عاملين بالشركة ومقاولين، وتحت إشراف الفريق يوجد 13 برج حفر حالياً في مختلف مناطق الكويت ما بين حفر وإصلاح، إذ يحتاج كل برج حفر إلى 70 موظفاً كحد أدنى لتشغيله في النوبتين، ويحرص الفريق على سلامة العاملين كافة ىن مأكل ومشرب وحالتهم الصحية ولياقتهم البدنية ومواصلاتهم، بالإضافة الى توقيع تصاريح الدخول لكل موظف إلى الحقل وتوقيع الفواتير المتعلقة بتكاليف أعمال الحفر لكافة الأبراج.

وقام الفريق بتنظيم احتفالية لتكريم العاملين على برج العقر SD-15 بعضور مدير مجموعة الحقر التطويري (2) على الصالح، تم فيها تكريم كافة العاملين الذين يصل عددهم الى 150 في يعض الأحيان، في احتفالية تعتبر عربون شكر للجهود الموصولة والمتضافرة بين أعضاء الفريق عاملي الحفر لمساهمتهم في هذا النجاح،

. فلل الاحتفالية عرض تقديمي بيّن أن الفريق قاق الأهداف الموضوعة له للعام المالي، وذلك بحقر تسع أبار بدلاً من سبع، فيما بلغت نسبة الزمن المستغرق للأنشطة غير المتعلقة بالإنتاج Non Productive Time NPT في العالم الماضي 7.5 بالمثة، بينما قلت هذه النسبة خلال العام الحالي إلى 5 بالمثة للبرج الفائز، وذلك بفضل عمال الحفر والمهندسين

تطوير الحقول، وذلك في كل مكمن نفطي حسب المواصفات الفنية والمعايير الم



مقاييس القوز باللقب

وذكر العنزى أن المقاييس التي وضعها لاختبار أفضل برج حقر للعام هي أقل زمن مستغرق في أداء الأنشطة غير المتعلقة بالإنتاج، وأعلى كفاءة اثناء العمليات المتعلقة بالحفر، على سبيل المثال السرعة الأمنة في عملية إنزال مثقاب الحفر إلى عمق الحقرة ووصل

مبادرة أطلقهارئيس فريق عمل الحفر التطويرى وإصلام الأبار (5) دخيلً العنزي وتقام للسنة الثالثة على التوالي

الأنابيب ببعضها ميكانيكياً، وهي عملية تعتمد على العنصر البشري لإتمامهاً، وسرعة التحكم بمانع الانفجار، إذ يتم إغلاقه في حال حدوث ضغط من داخل الحفرة إلى خارجها، ويتم تبديل هذه الموانع بحسب تغير ضغط الحفرة وعمقها، كما أن الالتزام بمعايير الصحة والسلامة والبيثة وتحقيق أكبر عدد ممكن من ساعات العمل الآمنة هي أيضاً من المقاييس التي تؤخذ في الحسبان، وهذه جميعها كان برج حفر SD-15 متفوقاً فيها لهذا العام. والزمن المستغرق في الحفر يعتمد على نوع

وعمق وشكل البثر إذا ما كانت عميقة أو سطحية، ويتعامل القريق مع الآبار السطحية التي أيضاً تختلف بأعماقها وأشكالها، اذ قد تكون أفقية الشكل أو يزاوية، أو ذا حتايا (S-SHAPE) أو (J-SHAPE)، بما يؤثر على



الأنبوب العالق باستخدام أساليب مختلفة، وإن لم ينجح الإجراء، يتم إغلاق الحقرة من أعلى الانبوب العالق وإعادة فتحها من اتجاه

اخر عن طريق الحفر التوجيهي. ومن التحديات الأخرى التي تواجه عملية الحقر هو التعامل مع المجهول، فقد يحدث بأن يكون ضغط البتر مرتفعاً، فتتم السيطرة على البئر بإغلاقها بإحكام باستخدام صمام مانع الانفجار ومن ثم بدء عملية تسمى بقتل

خطوات الحفر

الى اشتعال البتر.

البئر بزيادة وزن سائل الحفر، فيشكل ضغطا

معاكساً يقاوم الضغط الناتج عن البئر، وبذلك

يتم التحكم بها، وإن لم يتم إغلاق البئر في

الوقت المناسب عند ملاحظة ارتفاع ضغطها.

فإن هذا قد يؤدي إلى تدفق سوائل الطبقات

من المواد الهيدروكربونية الى الحقرة ومن ثم

الى السطح بدون تحكم، ما قد يؤدي بالتالي

 شخ سائل الحفر "الطفلة Mud" لرفع ناتج الحفر من القاع إلى السطح. 4. إنتاج النقط الذي يتم بشكل طبيعي بسبب الضغط الطبيعي للبتر أو عن طريق الرفع الاصطناعي، إذ تحتاج بعض الآبار إلى تحفيز الإنتاج.



It's easy to get bogged down with the daily grind of work, but it's important to stay positive when you're on the clock. Even if your boss isn't the type to pat you on the back, there are ways to keep from being bummed out every morning when your alarm goes off. These easy tips will help you stay positive at work.

1. Keep learning.

Just because you're not in school anymore and you have a job, you don't have to stop learning. On-the-job education is the best way to build up your resume. Learn as much as you can from every work experience you have, from presenting during a meeting to giving a tour of your workplace to outsiders. If you don't have a chance to learn from new things, ask your coworkers or bosses if you can accompany them when they do their duties, and learn about what they do.

2. Teach others what you know.

You want to accompany others when they do their jobs, so offer that opportunity to your coworkers. Instead of helping them out only when they ask, offer to teach them what you know so they won't have to call you all of the time. It might feel good to be needed (talk about job security!), but when you have your own list of tasks to do, being called to help someone else can be inconvenient. You know what they say: "Give a man a fish and you feed him for a day; teach him how to fish and you have fed him for a lifetime."

3. Give yourself a break.

You're on the clock for eight hours a day, and you're expected to work that entire time, but you can't really do that. Trying to work nonstop means you're wearing yourself out, and each subsequent task you do will get a little sloppier as you lose focus and motivation. Take a short break every hour or two. Step away from your desk and stretch, get some fresh air. You might spend five to fifteen minutes not working, but you'll feel so refreshed by the time you come back to your office that you'll be ready to get to work immediately.

4. Leave work at work.

It's important to have time to yourself, your family, and your hobbies. If you work for eight hours, clock out, and then come home to do more work, you're not going to be excited to go back to work the next day. Make a rule where you have to leave your work at the office. If you don't complete a task while you're clocked in, make it a priority for the next morning, but leave it at work. It's hard not to even think about work while you're at home because it's such a large portion of your life, but give it a try. The more you put it out of your mind, the more rejuvenated you'll feel each morning when it's time to go back to the office.

5. Build relationships with coworkers.

Your work environment will be more comfortable and fun if you're friendly with your coworkers. You don't have to know every detail of their personal lives, or even the names of their children, but having a good back and forth with coworkers, bosses, and associates will make your workplace more inviting. Having a friendly community at work will also make you feel more supported in your work duties, which can help cut stress levels.

6. Participate in after-work activities.

When the clock strikes five, you're more than ready to go home, but don't let this attitude take over and leave you out of work events. If some of the crew are going out for dinner or drinks, tag along every once in awhile. This helps build a community in the workplace, and you'll feel more connected to your coworkers. After all, you might still be with work people, but you won't be at work, so you'll still feel like you're having time outside of the office for yourself.

7. Make your workplace nice.

Whether you have an office, a cubicle, , or a desk in the middle of a crowded room, make your workplace nice! Check with your boss to see what kind of decorations are allowed, and then bring in some posters that motivate you, or family pictures that make you smile. Even something as small as bringing in your own coffee mug instead of using a Styrofoam cup can make your desk seem more homey. Sitting in an environment that looks nice and makes you feel good will do wonders for your motivation.



8. Volunteer to spearhead a project.

Instead of waiting to be assigned a project and getting stuck with something you might not like, why not volunteer to take on a project? This way you'll have more control over your tasks and you'll look great to your bosses. They'll be thrilled that you've willingly taken on more work, and will be more likely to consider you for the best of future projects and maybe even promotions.

9. Concentrate on one thing at a time.

You have a lot of things on your To Do list, but concentrating on one thing at a time will help you be more motivated and focused. If you stay on task until it's finished, you won't lose time by multitasking or changing course from one topic to another. By concentrating on one thing at a time, you also are more likely to complete more tasks fully, instead of doing bits and pieces of a bunch of different projects but not finishing any.

10. Set attainable goals.

Instead of setting your sights on the moon, set attainable work goals. It's good to have dreams, but if you dream too big and don't make it, you might be discouraged when it comes to accomplishing other goals. If you set attainable goals and meet them, you'll be more inspired to set more goals you can reach.

11. Use your imagination.

Don't restrict yourself to straightforward business practices – use your imagination! Take a creative approach to your projects and presentations, and brainstorm any task you're given

12. Don't beat yourself up over mistakes.


15. Smile more.
